

Awarding the best performers in APY (For period till 31/12/2015)

A. Best Performing Bank in APY

1. The best performing Banks in APY will be awarded to banks in the category of PSB, PVT, RRB and Coop Banks. The number of awards would be 3 each in PSB and RRB , 2 each in Pvt banks and cooperative bank category.
2. The scoring pattern is as mentioned below,

4	Migration of eligible Swavalamban Subscribers to APY. Minimum migration of 1000 accounts to be eligible.	10 marks	The bank with highest migration will get 10 marks and the second highest bank will get 8 marks. All the other banks with 1000 and above will get 5 marks.

B. Best performing Branch

One top performing branch of each bank in the category of PSB, Pvt Banks, RRB and Coop Banks will be awarded on mobilizing a minimum of 150 accounts.

C. Best performing Post offices and circles of Dept of Posts

- The top three post offices will be awarded on mobilizing a minimum number of 50 APY accounts.

- The top three circles of DoP will be awarded. Eligibility -Minimum 30% post offices under its jurisdiction sourced 50 accounts or more.

D. Best Performing individual BC/Corporate BC.

- The BC score card of the banks would be obtained from all banks and high performing BCs in terms of APY enrolment will be awarded to the top individual BC and corporate BC.
- The total number of awards under the category will be 2 each for individual and corporate BC among all banks.
- Eligibility: Minimum 100 APY accounts in case of individual BC and 1000 accounts for corporate BCs.

Selection Panel

The selection panel consists of a committee of 2 members as mentioned below,

1. Member 1 – Whole Time Member (Economics), PFRDA
2. Member 2 – Chief General Manager, PFRDA
3. Member 3 – CEO, NPST.

The winners will be awarded in a special function at New Delhi and the details will be provided later.
